### **GOD'S SOVEREIGN GRACE**

<u>2 Timothy 1:8</u> So do not be ashamed to testify about our Lord, or ashamed of me his prisoner. But join with me in suffering for the gospel, by the power of God, <sup>9</sup> who has saved us and called us to a holy life—not because of anything we have done but because of his own purpose and grace. This grace was given us in Christ Jesus before the beginning of time

<u>Ephesians 1:3</u> Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, <sup>4</sup>even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. In love <sup>5</sup>he predestined us for adoption as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will, <sup>6</sup>to the praise of his glorious grace, with which he has blessed us in the Beloved. <sup>7</sup>In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace...

<u>Romans 8:28</u> And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose. <sup>29</sup>For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the likeness of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. <sup>30</sup>And those he predestined, he also called; those he called, he also justified; those he justified, he also glorified.

#### BY HIS SOVEREIGN GRACE...

 God <u>CHOSE</u> people for Himself before He created the world

<u>Ephesians 1:4</u> For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight.

(See Eph. 1:11; I Thess. 1:4; I Pet. 1:2;2:9; Rom . 11:5)

- 2. God <u>PLACED</u> His chosen people 'in Christ' before the beginning of time
- <u>2 Timothy 1:9</u> [God] who has saved us and called us to a holy life—not because of anything we have done but because of his own purpose and grace. This grace was given us in Christ Jesus before the beginning of time...
- <u>1 Corinthians 1:30</u> It is because of him that you are in Christ Jesus. (See I Cor. 1:4, Eph. 1:3;2:6)
- 3. God <u>WORKS</u> in all things for the good of His chosen people <u>Romans 8:28</u> And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.

(See Heb. 12:10; Eph. 1:18-19; Phil. 2:13)

4. God will completely **TRANSFORM** every last one of His chosen people into the likeness of Jesus

<u>Romans 8:29</u> For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the likeness of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. (See 2 Cor. 3:18; Phil. 3:21; I John 3:2)
