



Why do we need to see Jesus in the Old Testament?

1. Jesus **SAID** that the Old Testament **POINTED TO HIM**.
John 5:39-40 (ESV)

2. Jesus **TAUGHT** others how the Old Testament is **ABOUT HIM**.
Luke 24:13-35 (ESV)

How can we begin to see Jesus in the Old Testament?

1. **READ ABOUT AND STUDY** Jesus in the New Testament **FIRST**.

2. Look for times where the New Testament **REFERS TO OR QUOTES** the Old Testament.

“it is written”

When Studying the Old Testament Ask Yourself...

1. How is this **CHARACTER** like or unlike Jesus and how is Jesus a **BETTER VERSION?**

2. Does the **THING** you are reading about **REPRESENT OR FORESHADOW** Jesus?

3. Does the **STORY** you are reading **REMIND** you of Jesus in any way?
