

#3 Gospel-Formed Community



Two Key Aspects:

- 1. Grasping the GOSPEL **PROPELS US** to be part of community
- 2. Being part of true gospel community helps **FORM** the GOSPEL inside us

KEY TRUTH: The Gospel of Christ has the power to transform our relationships within the church – how we see and relate to others in our spiritual family.

Psalm 68:5-6 (NIV) A father to the fatherless, a defender of widows, is God in his holy dwelling. God sets the lonely in **families**...

<u>Acts 2:46-47 (NIV)</u> <u>Every day</u> they continued to meet together in the **temple courts**. They broke bread in **their homes** and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, ⁴⁷ praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

<u>Hebrews 10:24-25 (NIV)</u> And let us consider how we may **spur one another on** toward love and good deeds, ²⁵**not giving up meeting together**, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

<u>Galatians 4:19 (NIV)</u> My dear children, for whom I am again in the pains of childbirth **until Christ is <u>formed</u> in you**...

Philippians 2:3-4, 12 (NIV) Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, ⁴ not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.

Christ-like Attitudes that Gospel Community helps form in us:

- **HUMILITY** = viewing yourself and others as God does and considering others to be more important (Philippians 2:3)
- **GRATEFULNESS** = expressing thankfulness to God for all we receive from Him (1 Corinthians 4:7)
- **<u>KINDNESS</u>** = relating to each other in honoring and respectful ways (Ephesians 4:32)
- **PATIENCE** = bearing with each other's faults, flaws, sins, and weaknesses (Romans 15:1)
- **OPENNESS** = trustfully growing in transparent honesty, willing even to uncover sin (James 5:15)
- <u>REPENTANCE</u> = turning away from sinful patterns of relating to each other (Ephesians 4:31)
- <u>ACCEPTANCE, GRACE & FORGIVENESS</u> = welcoming people as they are, offering them unconditional respect, and refusing to hold a grudge against them when they offend you; instead, releasing them from the obligation of their offense (Ephesians 4:32)
- **PRIORITY** = seeking to do good, especially to others in God's family (Galatians 6:10)
- **SERVICE** = willingly expending oneself to help others become truly successful (2 Corinthians 12:15)

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
