#### WHY WORSHIP?

#### 1. Because God alone is <u>WORTHY</u> of your worship

<u>Isaiah. 6:1</u> In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord seated on a throne, high and exalted, and the train of his robe filled the temple. <sup>2</sup>Above him were seraphs, each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying. <sup>3</sup>And they were calling to one another: "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory."

#### 2. Because you were <u>CREATED</u> for worship

<u>Acts 17:26</u> From one man he made every nation of men, that they should inhabit the whole earth; and he determined the times set for them and the exact places where they should live. <sup>27</sup>God did this so that men would seek him and perhaps reach out for him and find him, though he is not far from each one of us.

#### 4. Because you will <u>BECOME</u> what you worship

<u>Psalm 115:1</u> Not to us, O LORD, not to us but to your name be the glory, because of your love and faithfulness. <sup>2</sup>Why do the nations say, "Where is their God?" <sup>3</sup>Our God is in heaven; he does whatever pleases him. <sup>4</sup>But their idols are silver and gold, made by the hands of men. <sup>5</sup>They have mouths, but cannot speak, eyes, but they cannot see; <sup>6</sup>they have ears, but cannot hear, noses, but they cannot smell; <sup>7</sup>they have hands, but cannot feel, feet, but they cannot walk; nor can they utter a sound with their throats. <sup>8</sup>Those who make them will be like them, and so will all who trust in them.

#### 5. Because worship <u>FUELS</u> your <u>SOUL</u>

<u>Psalm 42:11</u> Why are you downcast, O my soul? Why so disturbed within me? Put your hope in God, for I will yet praise him, my Savior and my God.
